Recladding work

The installation of new A1 rated aluminium cladding is continuing on floors 19-16. It's taking a little longer than we hoped and we are now estimating that work on floors 15-12 will start on 2 September, which is three weeks later than planned. We're doing everything we can to recover this time back.

Progress on the leasehold block

- Roof terrace: the new cladding brackets are being fixed and aluminium cladding installed
- Floors 19-16: the panels on the south side are taking longer to fit than we planned due to an alignment issue, but this has now been resolved and things are progressing.

Progress on the rented block

• The installation of the scaffolding was temporally suspended in July because there were a few incidents where objects fell off balconies above, narrowly missing the workers. Please take extra care with objects on your balcony to avoid near misses like this and make sure that small children are supervised while the work is taking place. This is for everyone's safety and peace of mind. The scaffold is now up to level six on all sides and we are hoping to recover the time lost.

Leaseholders: we need to temporarily disconnect your balcony lights

If you're a leaseholder, Hill will need to disconnect your balcony lights for a short period to continue the recladding work. The next weekend appointment has been booked for Saturday 10 August. Sprinkler testing

The sprinkler testing is going well. Results from some flats appeared to show that sometimes the alarm was not sounding when the sprinkler was activated. We looked into this and discovered that the alarms on some sprinklers had been set to go off to up 30 seconds after the sprinkler activated.

We'll be looking out for this in all our future tests and readjusting the settings as necessary, so the alarm goes off immediately with the sprinkler.

We have arranged for more sates for sprinklers to be tested. If you have not yet had your sprinklers tested, please call AJS on **0208 597 7000 to arrange an appointment slot**:

- 12 -13 September.

We'll need to go back to the flats we've already visited, as they'll need their flow switches adjusted.

We're making good progress on replacing the glass balcony panels, with floors 19-3 now complete on the leasehold block. Discreption of the leasehold block is complete, work to the rented block will start from the bottom floors up.
