Re: Fire Strategy Changing to Evacuation

I am writing to advise you of an important change to the fire strategy at Luma Apartments.

We have reviewed the latest guidance with our fire safety experts Savills and were advised on 3 September that the fire strategy for Luma Apartments should be changed to a <u>total evacuation strategy</u>. This means if a fire breaks out you must evacuate the building immediately.

Background

We continually review the fire safety of our buildings and following a recent intrusive investigation, we identified some gaps in the cavity barriers behind the external wall cladding which need to be fixed.

Luma Apartments was designed to operate a stay put policy, meaning that unless you are directly affected by a fire you should remain within your home; but until we fix the gaps in the cavity barriers, we've decided the safest thing to do is change the strategy to total evacuation.

New fire strategy for Luma Apartments

The new strategy for Luma Apartments means if a fire breaks out you must **evacuate the building immediately**. This change will take effect from today. We are taking immediate steps to support this change:

- Implementing fire wardens who will be patrolling the block
- The fire wardens will raise the alarm if there is a fire by knocking on doors and using horns
- We have notified the Fire Brigade of this change and invited them to review the arrangements we have put in place

• All fire notices in communal areas will be changed to inform everyone that they must evacuate if there is a fire. Please take a moment to familiarise yourself with this notice.

We also plan to install a system to warn residents as quickly as possible if there is a fire.

What should you do if there is a fire in your flat?

- Evacuate immediately using the stairs
- Close all doors behind you when leaving your flat
- Tell the fire wardens about the fire
- Call 999.

What should you do if a fire warden tells you to evacuate?

- Follow instructions and immediately evacuate using the stairs
- Do not pack or bring any possessions with you
- Close all doors behind you
- Tell the fire wardens or the Fire Brigade of any family members need assistance to evacuate
- Gather at the assembly point <u>on the pavement in front of Aurora House</u> A location map is below:


